SLED is a flexible program that can be implemented wherever it fits into the school day. SLED is most effective as an **afterschool enrichment program**, **elective class**, or **club** that meets at least twice weekly

How SLED Works

SLED positions students to identify real world problems facing their school, then helps them develop the necessary skills to **create and execute projects** that solve those problems.

A **National Competition** is held to award SLED Chapters with the greatest community impact each school year. Thousands of dollars in prize money are given to the winning Chapters so that they can sustain and expand.


Advisor Support
